

This is a checklist of all required materials necessary for a completed admissions application to the University of Pikeville-Kentucky College of Optometry (KYCO). Based on the submitted application and information, applicants will be invited for an on-site interview. All application materials must be received by the Kentucky College of Optometry by the \_\_\_\_\_ deadline. Admission to the Kentucky College of Optometry is determined on a rolling basis. Early application is highly recommended.
